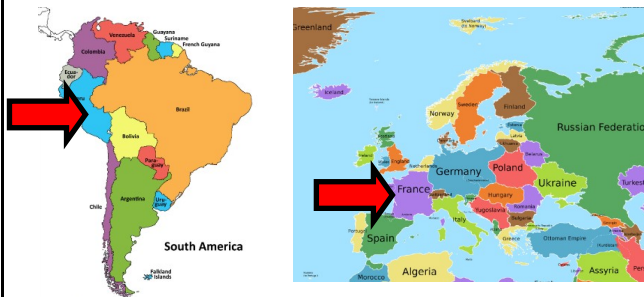


What should I already be able to do?

Peru and France on their continents

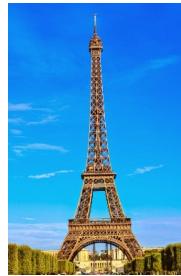


What Will I know by the end of this enquiry

- France is on the European continent.
- Paris is the capital city of France.
- The language generally spoken in France is French.
- The climate in France is continental meaning it is warm in the summer and can be cold in the winter. France is hotter than the UK and not as cold as the UK.



- Peru is on the South American continent.
- Lima is the capital city of Peru
- Machu Picchu is one of the seven wonders of the world.
- Spanish is the spoken language in Peru.
- The climate is tropical but there is also mountain and desert climates too.

Vocabulary

Word	Meaning
Country	A nation with its own government.
Continent	The world's largest expanses of land
Physical features	Natural features such as seas, mountains and rivers.
Human features	Features of a country such as houses, bridges and roads which are built by humans.
Landscapes	Visible features of an area of land.
Tourist	A person who visits another place or country where they don't reside.
Landmarks	A feature of a landscape or country which can be easily seen or recognised for a distance. It can also be a significant landmark for a country.
Population	A group of people who live in a particular place.
Compare	Noticing the similarities and differences between two or more subjects.
