	Land use	The purposes for using land e.g. agricultural, educational, recreational, residential (homes) etc	
	Rural areas	The country side, outside of cities. These have lower populations and are smaller settlements.	
	Urban areas	A built up area which is larger than rural areas. Their populations are greater too.	
	Climate change	The long-term shifts in the Earth's temperatures and weather patterns. This can be from natural or human causes.	
	Sculpture	3D representations of abstract forms. They can be made our of different materials e.g. wood, metal, plaster etc. Sculptures are a form of art.
