Write a character description about the Queen. Remember to use the correct punctuation. Can you include some interesting adjectives to describe what she is like?

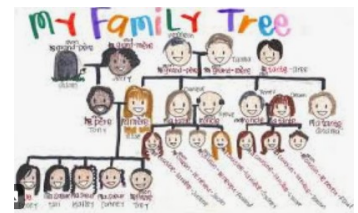


Research

Think about... what we learned last term about how we can use shapes

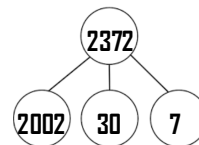


Maths
