To identify and narrow the gap of under-achieving groups of children within the school				Overall the outcomes for KS2 children at the end of 24-25 were above national average and outcomes for EYFS children and KS1 phonics were in line with national average. This would indicate that children across all areas are being supported with both targeted and reactive intervention. However, more work needs to be carried out to fine hone assessment of vulnerable groups, especially those with SEND, to ensure that correct intervention is put in place and, where appropriate, rapid progress can take place

Children have access to other cultures through the curriculum that was established last year. Throughout the year, children will learn about different artist, scientist and significant people from history through the lens of local, national and international perspectives.
